FUTURE TRAINERS WORKSHOP
FIRST APPLICATION
2011, 19 April, Vichy, France**

A. Introduction

The FTW (Future Trainers workshop) first modified application, with integration of the 2.1. of CSC Document on website, is presented in this chapter.

This workshop will be held for the first time at the Conference in Vichy 2011. It may be held at future conferences in the same or in a revised way.

The Future Trainers Workshop is designed for certified members who are interested in becoming IP Trainers. Some Certified members may already have started to provide some kind of IP training. The Future Trainers Workshop is considered one of the steps before beginning a formal supervised training to become a Trainer, and before being allowed to provide recognized Training. Please read the Document we have on the IIPA website about the Training for Trainers.

First Application: To be qualified for the workshop, interested members must already have chosen their Primary IIPA Trainer - CIPTS or CIIPCTS - with whom they have discussed the process of their becoming IP Trainers and Supervisors. The most significant job for the Future Trainer is to contact the Primary Trainer and verify his or her motivations for becoming a Trainer/Supervisor, and his or her professional preparation. The Future Trainer and Primary Trainer must then design a personal trainer training program before the FTW. The first deadline for the FTW application was February 28, 2011.

After this Future Trainer Workshop, the CIPT-CIPC who participated will be named "Trainer and Supervisor under Tutorship." Their title will be UT-IPTS until their future CIPTS evaluation. UT-IPTS role is not a definitive status or conclusive step. If the UT-IPTS does not complete their CIPTS evaluation according to the IIPA requirements, they have to participate in the next FTW at the next IIPA Conferences. At the next conference they will be invited to share their experiences with the other colleagues and will be eligible to complete their requirements to become a Trainer.

Since one of the aims of this workshop is to welcome and help members to become prepared to train and supervise, and to aid them in identifying areas of growth for their future professional development as Trainers and Supervisors, at the end of the workshop, the staff of the FTW will give the Future trainer written feedback, which the UT-IPTSs should bring back to his or her own Primary Trainer/Supervisor.

After the workshop, the Future Trainer must continue to receive supervision under tutorship as per their agreement with their Primary Supervisor, to whom they will both provide a copy of the FTW feedback, and discuss the written feedback they have received. Hopefully this feedback will help both the Future Trainer and his or her supervisor assess the Future Trainer's basic competencies in terms of their training and supervision, their personal strengths, and their needed areas for professional growth.

The Future Trainer participants will be also be asked to give written feedback about what they learned from the workshop, along with suggestions about how we may continue to improve the Future Trainer Workshops.

This Workshop will be accredited towards training hours by IIPA. The training which the UT-IPTS will provide after this Workshop will be recognized by IIPA.

B. FTW schedule for Vichy 2011

(3 hours) TRANSLATION PROVIDED-free

The workshop will be held on 19 April from 14:30 to 17:30 and will consist of 4 parts.

1. About 60 minutes

In the first part all 15 participants and the CIPTS with CSC Chair and the FTW Coordinator will form a group. The following contents and processes will be focused upon:

- CSC Chair and FTW Coordinator will give an explanation of the FTW purposes.
- The CIPTS-CIPTSC will give a short introduction of themselves that includes sharing the most important issues they have faced in their experience as Trainer.
- CSC Chair and FTW Coordinator will facilitate the Future Trainers briefly introducing themselves. Along with stating his or her name, and the name of their Primary IIPA Trainer Supervisor, candidates may also describe the major experiences and motivations that lead them to want to become Trainers and Supervisors.
- The participants will receive the following Documents:
 - i. Training Standards for CIPTS & CIPTSC;
 - ii. Appendix on Supervisor Credits;
 - iii. Fundamentals Theory present chart
 - iv. A formal paper of endorsement for UT-IPTS or UT-IPTSC :
 - v. Requirements: every 2 years, in the next IIPA conference , the UT-IPTS and UT-IPTSC must participate in a new similar meeting with peers and trainers until their final IIPA CIPTS_CIPTSC evaluation

2. About 80 minutes.

The participants will be placed into 3 groups of 5 persons with 2 trainers each. The Trainers will lead the discussion. All together, CIPTS-CIPTSC and Future trainers will ask questions, engage in a joint discussion, and then give feedback about the process.

Each future trainer could choose the point he/she prefers: EXAMPLES of some THEMES and issues which might be focused upon:

- Personal projects as trainer and/or supervisor
 - Motivation to become a trainer and supervisor
- IP Supervision and training process and philosophy
- Strengths as IP trainer and supervisor
- Personal and professional points to develop and how
- Present relevant ethical issues
- How do you see your profession in 10 years
- IP fundamentals and other approaches

3. About 20 minutes.

Future trainers will write individual feedback about themselves, about their own learning through this workshop experience, and will also receive individual written feedback by the 2 CIPTS in their group of five.

4. About 20 minutes.

The whole workshop will come back together. A report will be given from each group by the CIPTS-CIPTSC. (Additional themes from this workshop might be also be discussed, such as the Impact of IP in your country, connection with colleagues.)

Participant's feedback

(Feedback forms will be handed out by the Coordinators, and a copy will be sent to the secretary of the conference.)

- **Recognizing of difficulties,**
- **Management of difficulties**
- **Relationship with territories**
- **Other...**
